### **Updated Fairfield community reference guide updated and released**

FAIRFIELD, (Iowa) – The Fairfield Economic Development Association has released the 2010-11 Fairfield Community Quick Reference [CQR] guide to the community. “The Fairfield CQR is an exhaustive document full of detailed information on local and state taxes, business incentives and a host of other demographic and community information pertinent to FEDA’s facilitation of Fairfield’s economic development,” he added.
